

Prayer Shawl Pattern

Knitting Prayer Shawls is Good for You:

To learn about the healing and comforting powers of Prayer Shawls, please visit www.shawlministry.com.

The (easy) Pattern: Size 11 or 13 needles. Cast on either 54, 57, or 60 stitches and k3p3 every row. When starting a row, begin with the opposite stitch, so that you are knitting the purls and purling the knits. Continue for 57 inches. When done, add fringe to both ends.

The Wool: 3 skeins of Lion Brand Homespun, color of your choice. It is available at Michael's, AC Moore, and Joann Fabric. It will cost about \$18 (unless you find it on sale) to knit one shawl.
